Things to Know:

Price - Depends on the breeder, but an average price is around \$65 per rabbit When to Order - Start calling breeders around early November to see what they are expecting When to Pick Up -

- Breeder will let you know when to pick up, but expect it to be after Christmas
- Has to be purchased prior to validation on 1/16/24

At show, a pen of rabbits must consist of three (3) fryers of one recognized breed and variety, with each weighing 3 1/2 to 5 1/2 pounds.

Showing Rabbits:

Rabbit projects are a very short turn around. You will have the rabbits for around 6ish weeks. During this time you will need a rabbit hutch that can house the rabbits separately. Rabbits do not need to be housed in doors, just away from direct sunlight and harsh weather environments. Each rabbit needs their own food and water with enough room to move around. I recommend buying at least 4 rabbits. Rabbits will be shown in a pen of 3, but you will have one extra just in case of the unknown. Rabbits will need exercise and a chance to stretch their legs, so if you have other animals, make sure they are put up and you let your bunny exercise in a safe and fenced area.

Necessities:

- Food bowl
- Water drip
- Feed Breeder recommends certain types
- Rabbit Hutches Dry place and out direct weather/sun

- Shavings
- Travel pen Can be dog crates or buckets
- Nail Clippers Optional

MEAT RABBITS:

Meat rabbits cannot be older than 70 days of the county show. The meat rabbits' parents could not be bred earlier than 11/20/2023. I will attach a list of breeders. Please let me know if there are any questions.
